Laying a Foundation

Read Ruth 1-4 to prepare for today's lesson. This story is found in [The Beginner's Bible](#) on pages 152-155. This story is a beautiful story of redemption. We can see how Boaz acts as a kinsman-redeemer for Ruth. Boaz foreshadows Jesus. Jesus is the ultimate Kinsman-Redeemer for Israel, and for the church. After Boaz and Ruth marry, they have a baby whom they name Obed. Obed was the grandfather to King David; from King David's line will come Jesus!

We have been studying how God keeps His promises. This story is a wonderful example of God's faithfulness to Ruth and Naomi, but also to you and me!


David and His Family Bag

Today's Art is **Ruth and Naomi Diorama**

- Allow your child to color the scene of mountains, sky, sun and fields. Help them color the little pieces of wheat.
- Help your child fold on the dotted line. Glue the two bottom triangles together.
- Fold the little pieces of wheat on the dotted line and glue them into the diorama bottom.
- Talk about the story while you work.



Today's coloring sheet is titled **What Color is the Wheat?**.

Talk

As you make the diorama with your child, use these questions to help you review the story with your child:

- What were the two ladies names in the story? (Naomi and Ruth)
- What happened to their husbands? (They got sick and died.)
- What did Naomi decide to do after their husbands died? (She decided to move back to her home country of Israel.)
- What did Ruth decide to do? (Ruth decided to move with Naomi. She loved her very much.)
- How did the ladies eat in their new home? (Ruth went out every day and gathered the leftover wheat from the edges of the fields.)
- Who was the kind farmer that allowed her to be in the field? (His name is Boaz.)
- What happened in the end of the story? (Boaz married Ruth and they have a baby.)
