

# WEEK 3

**SUNDAY 4/18**

## Acts 2: 14-21

Praise God for Jesus being the fulfillment of the Old Testament promise of a Messiah. Just as Peter shared the truth of the Gospel with the Jewish people in Acts, we pray for the over 15,000 Jewish neighbors here in Charlotte who do not know Jesus.

**MONDAY 4/19**

## Acts 2:21

Praise God for the truth that all who call on the Lord will be saved! Pray, by name, for friends who don't know Jesus. Pray for an opportunity to have a meaningful gospel conversation with that person this week.



**TUESDAY 4/20**

## Acts 2:22-28

Praise God that Jesus rose from the dead! Pray for the 400,000+ people in Charlotte who have never believed or have walked away from Jesus. Pray they experience Jesus through believers and churches in our city.

**WEDNESDAY 4/21**

## Acts 2:28

Consider what it means to be full of gladness because of Jesus in your life. Write down the name of 3 other churches in Charlotte. Pray that their leaders and members would joyfully proclaim and demonstrate the Gospel of Jesus to the city of Charlotte.



**THURSDAY 4/22**

## Acts 2:29-36

Praise God that He has made Jesus both Lord and Christ. Consider the implication of Jesus as Lord in your life. Pray that you may let Him be Lord over all areas of your life.

**FRIDAY 4/23**

## Acts 2:37-39

Those listening to Peter's sermon had done the unthinkable. They killed Jesus. And yet, Peter calls them to repent and be saved. Consider the person/people for whom you are tempted to say "there is no hope for them." Pray now for their salvation, as there is still hope.



**SATURDAY 4/24**

## Acts 2:40-41

Do you take access to the gospel for granted? Almost none of the 10 million Pashtun of Afghanistan have ever heard a clear presentation of the gospel. Pray and ask God to provide opportunities for them to hear the life changing message of a Savior who died to save them.

## WEEK 4

SUNDAY 4/25

Acts 2:42-47

This passage of Scripture describes the fellowship enjoyed by the early followers of Christ. Pray for healthy Christian fellowship and community to increase so that we will be a light for our city.



MONDAY 4/26

Acts 2:42

Consider the obstacles that get in the way of prayer and studying Scripture. Pray that the Lord would give you a desire for His Word. Ask Him to help you prioritize fellowship and prayer.

TUESDAY 4/27

Acts 2:43

Pray that God would restore the "awe" of His glory in our hearts. Pray that God would continue to work through wonders and miracles all around the world, so that those who have never heard the name of Jesus may come to a saving faith in Him.

WEDNESDAY 4/28

Acts 2:44

Believing entails much more than merely knowing certain facts about Jesus. It involves complete faith and trust in Christ for the forgiveness of sins. Pray for someone by name who does not know Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord.



THURSDAY 4/29

Acts 2:45

Ask the Lord to give you the name of someone you can bless with an act of generosity as we see in this passage of Scripture. Pray for an open door for you to walk alongside someone who is in need.



FRIDAY 4/30

Acts 2:46

Ask the Lord to burden your heart for your neighbors. Pray for your neighbors by name. Pray for an opportunity to build a transformational relationship with one of your neighbors you don't know well.

SATURDAY 5/1

Acts 2:47

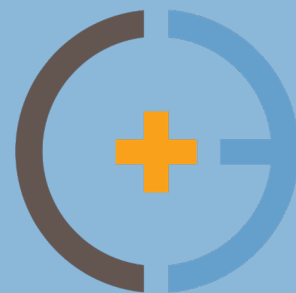
Spend your time in prayer worshipping the Lord. As you pray, remember His names, His righteousness, and His grace. Pray that people all over the world will hear His name.
